

# Insulated Ice Blankets for Cask and Keg Cooling

## Instructions for Preparation



**1**  
Fill the sink to a level which will allow the ice sheet to be fully immersed in water



**2**  
Immerse the ice sheet in the water, fold over if necessary.  
**Tip:** Warm water will absorb into the gel quicker speeding up hydration



**3**  
Holding the ice sheet under the water to begin with will help to start the hydration process



**4**  
The cells will inflate in approx. 10-15 minutes. The water is absorbed by the crystals in each cell that forms a freezing gel



**5**  
Check the cells are absorbing efficiently and evenly, they will begin to feel firm and bulky



**6**  
Once fully hydrated, remove from the water and repeat for as many sheets as you need



**7**  
If you have smaller freezer compartments, then fold the sheets in half ensuring foil to foil contact



**8**  
Place a plastic bag or cling film between the ice sheets if stacking them. Try to avoid stacking too many at a time as this will increase the freezing time and create an iceberg in your freezer

### Typical Freezing Time is 2-4 Hours

Freezing time will vary according to the type, volume and content of the freezer. The more ice sheets you try to freeze, the longer it will take

### Once Frozen

Once the ice sheet is frozen, lay it across your cask, or wrap around your keg. Even after thawing, the gel continues to provide cooling.

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# Insulated Ice Blankets for Cask and Keg Cooling

## Instructions For Use

If you have purchased a Roll of ice sheets, you are able to tear off the sheets to your preferred length.

If you have purchased the pre-cut pack, the sheets are 10 x 6 Cells, which is sufficient to cover half of a horizontally stillaged 9 Gallon Cask.

1. Remove the ice blanket from the packaging
2. To allow cask venting, use a sharp blade or scissors to cut a cross shaped split in the centre as Illustrated Below in **fig.1**
3. Follow the freezing instructions on the reverse side of this sheet
4. When the ice blanket is frozen, remove from the plastic bag
5. If you are using the ice blanket with an insulating jacket, place the blanket **SILVER SIDE DOWN** over the cask **fig.2**
6. If you are using the ice blanket alone, place the blanket on **SILVER SIDE UP** to reflect any radiant heat and reduce thawing time **fig.3**
